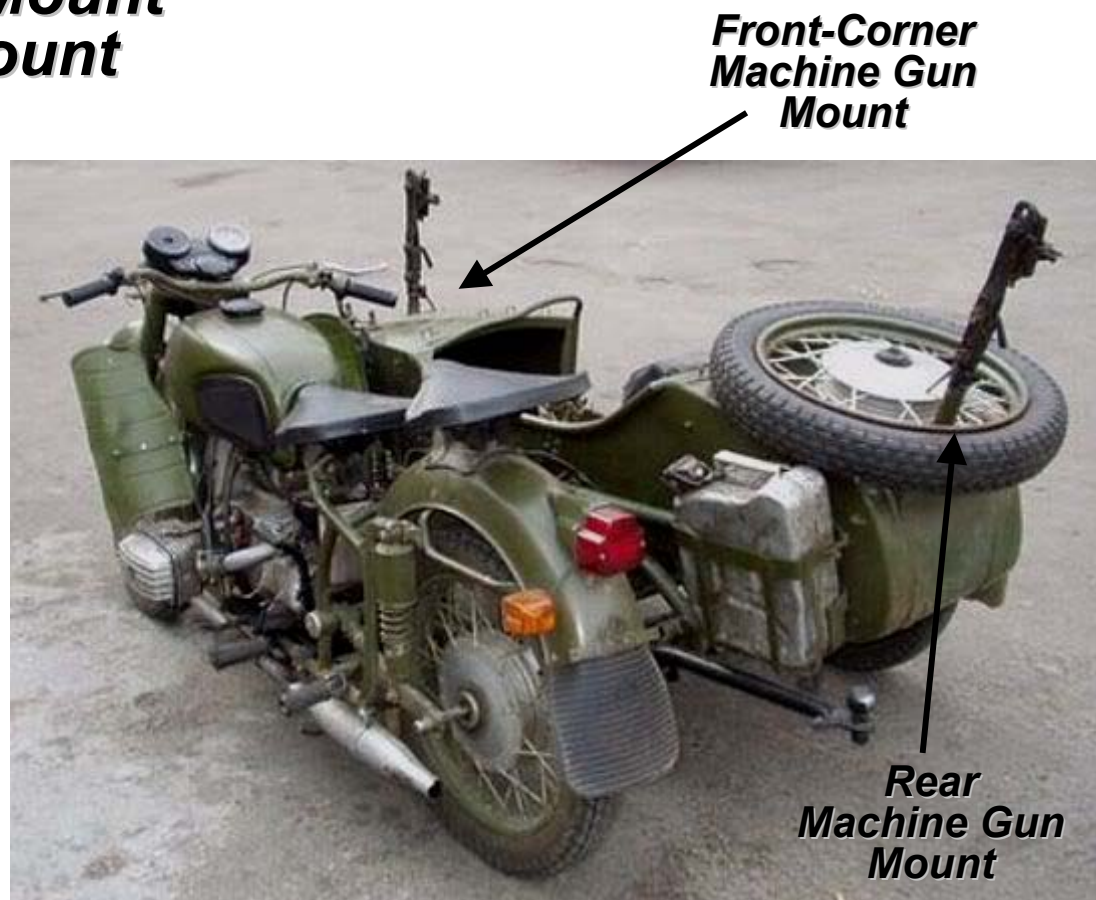

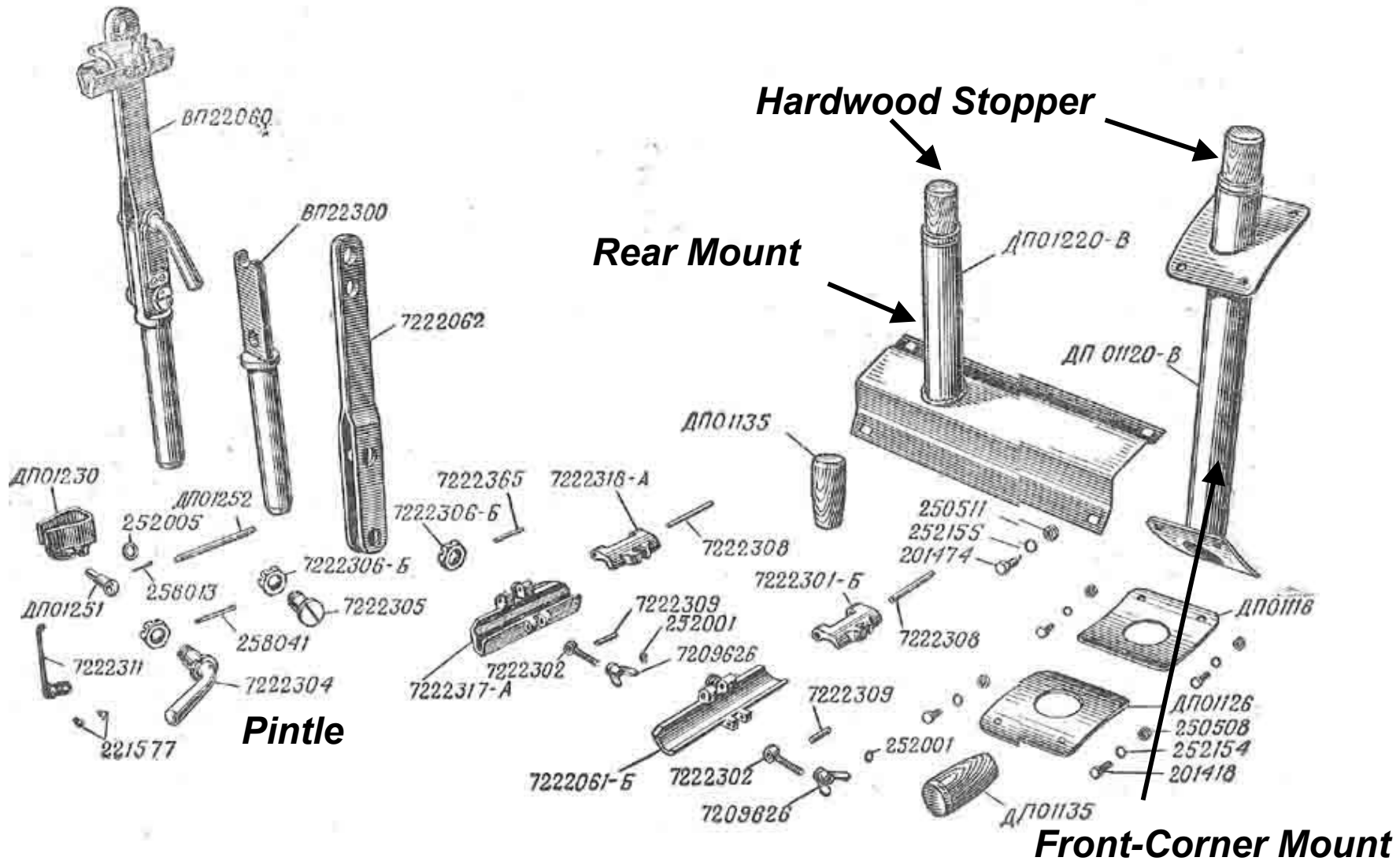

Diagram Showing Front and Rear MG Mounts + Pintle for MB-750/ MT-12

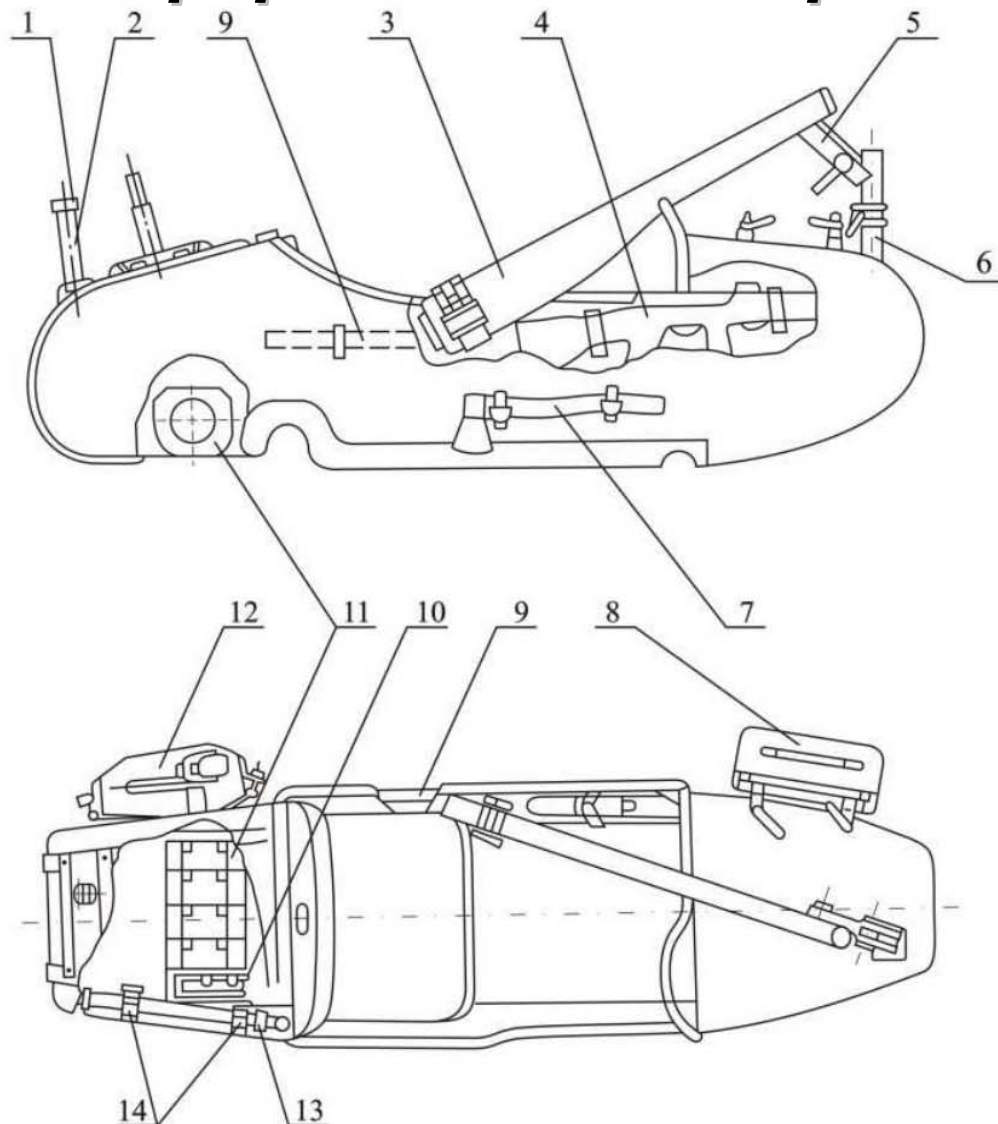


Both the front-corner and rear machine gun (MG) mounts accept the same pintle.

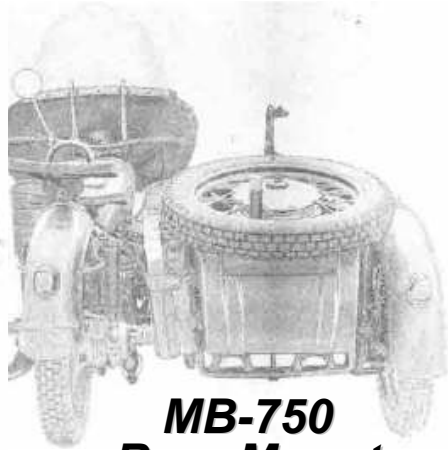

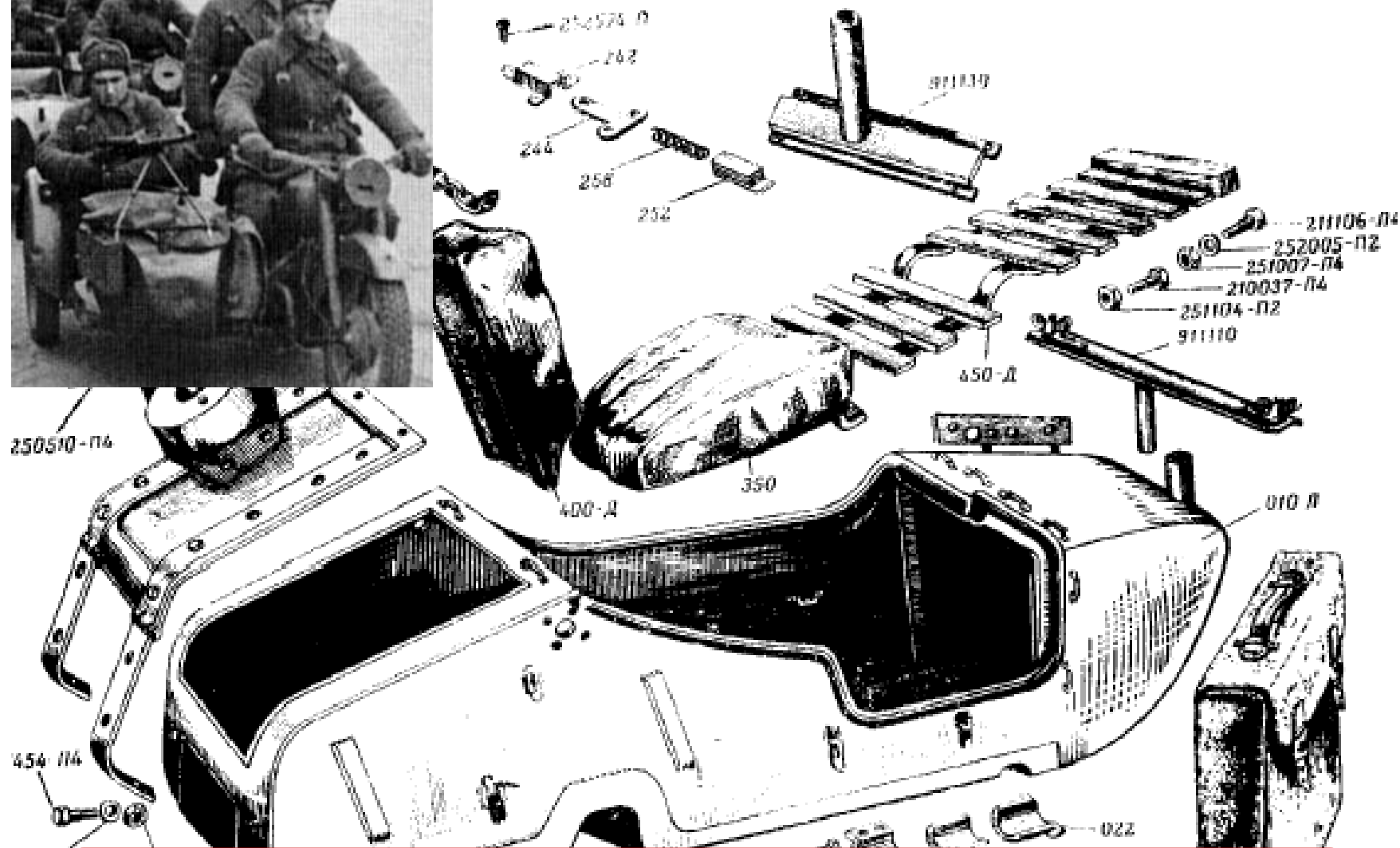
